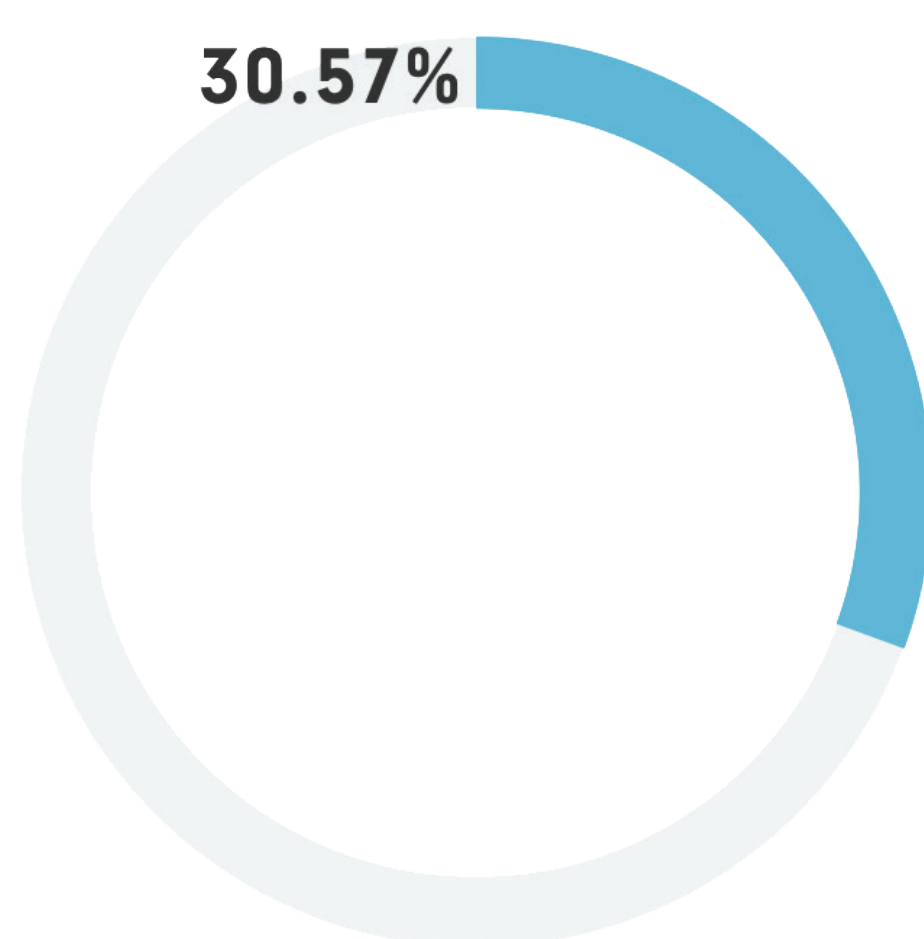
## Women's Economic Empowerment

Women in the Arab States have income security, decent work, and economic autonomy.

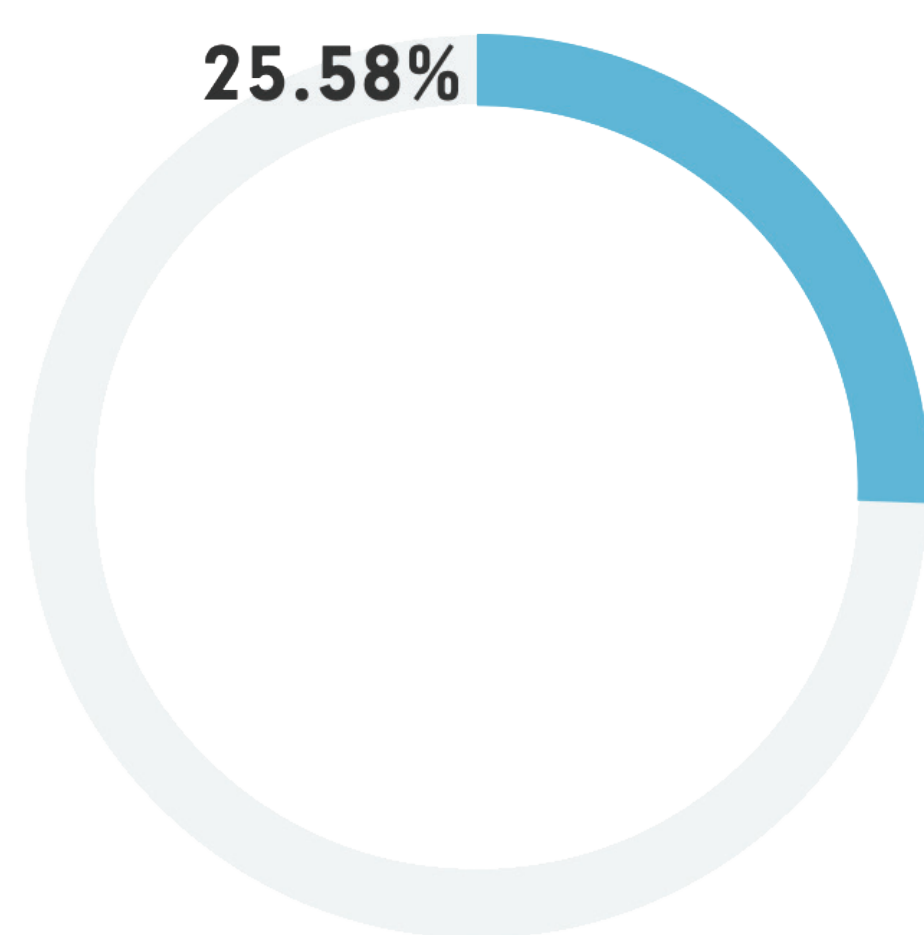


**Unemployment with advanced education, (% of labour force with advanced education)**

**Labour force participation rate, female (% of total population) (modeled ILO estimate)**

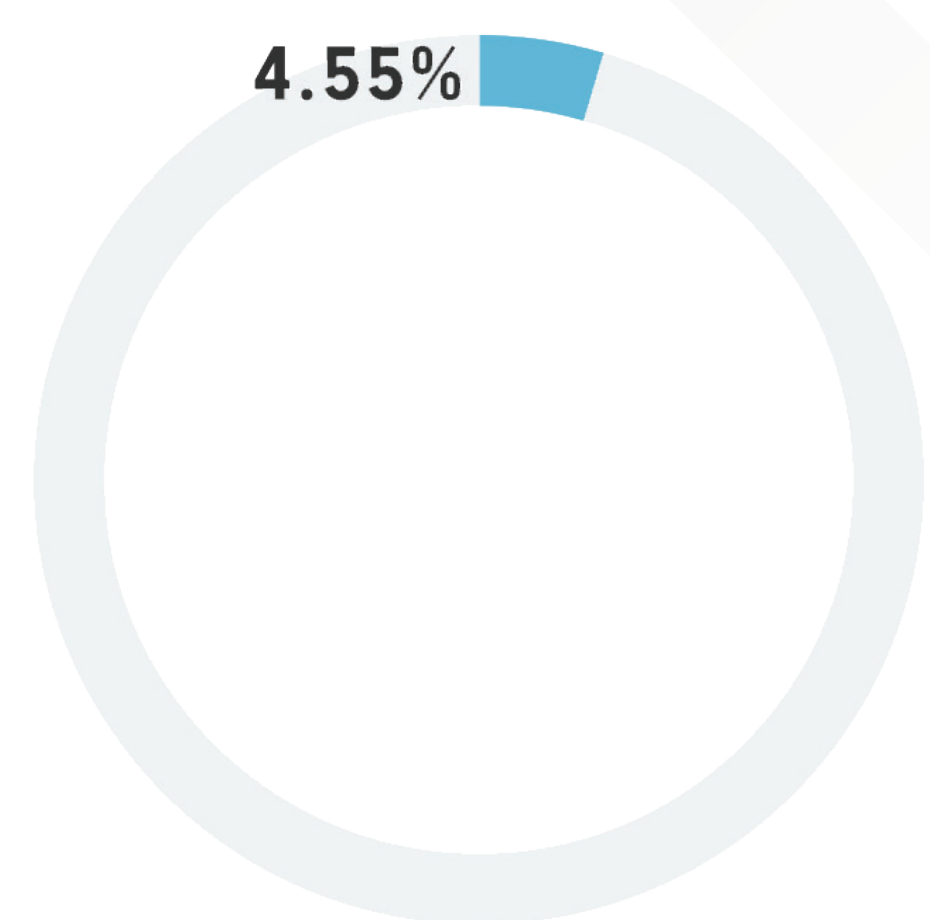

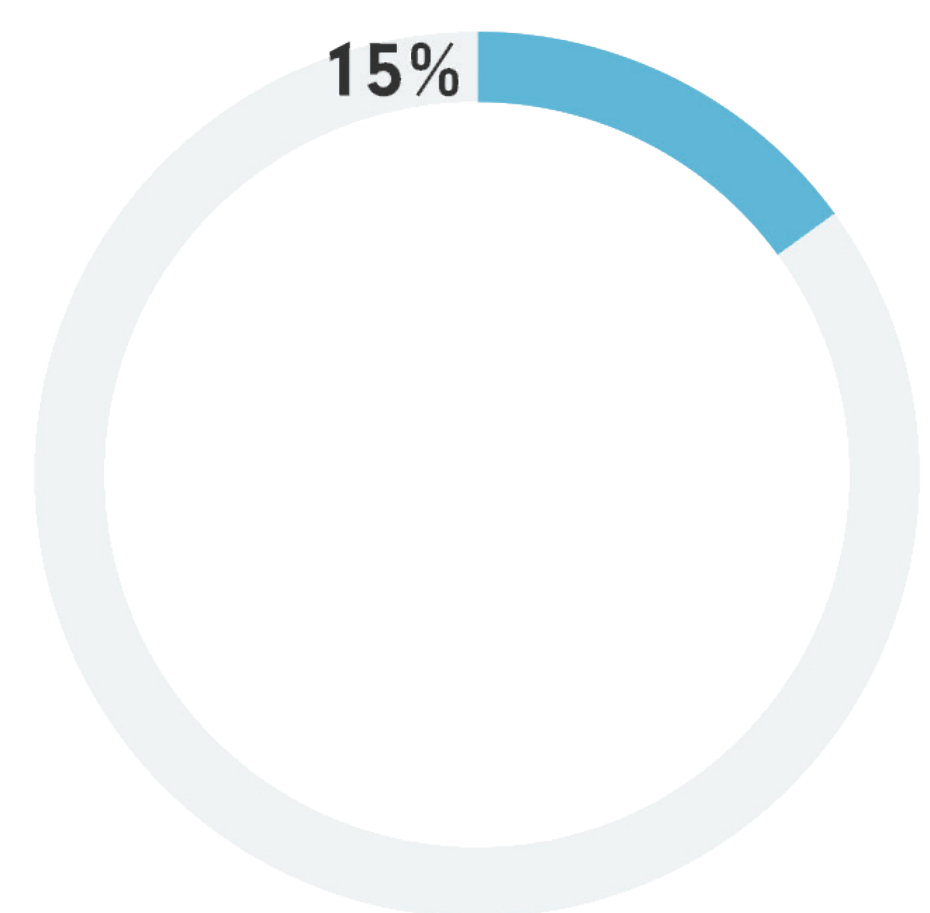
## Gender and Governance

Women in the Arab States fully and equally participate in leadership and decision-making, and women and girls benefit from gender responsive governance.

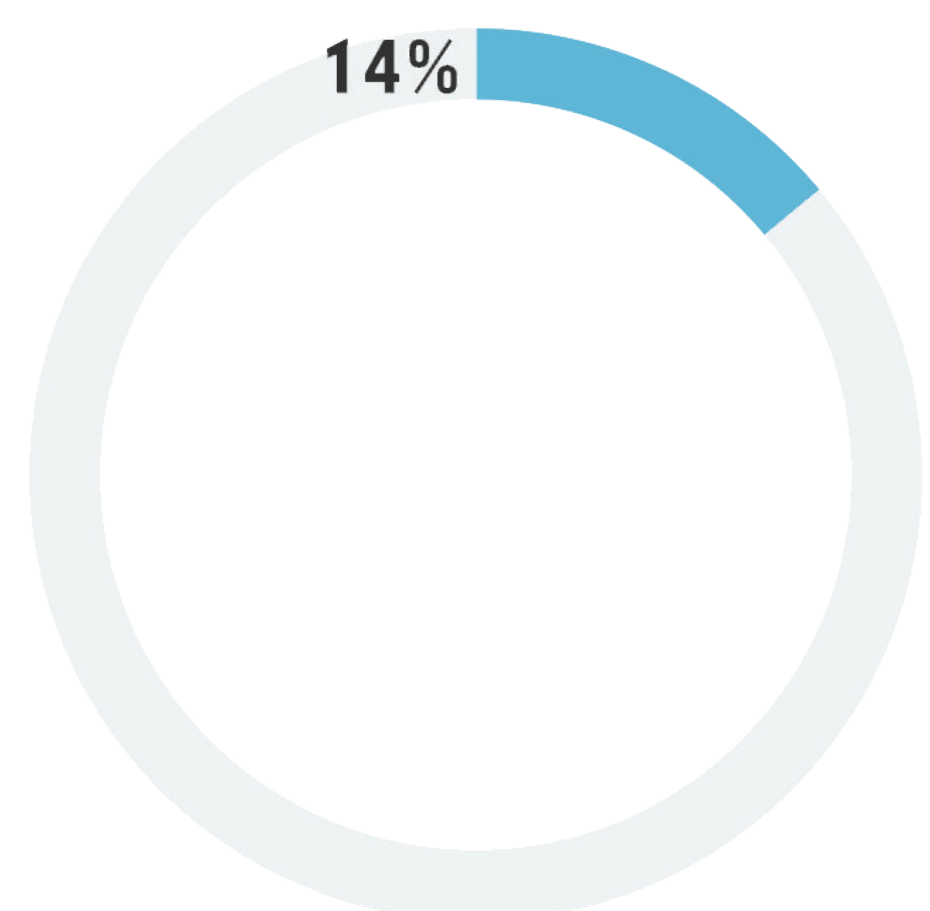


**Proportion of women in ministerial level positions (%)**
