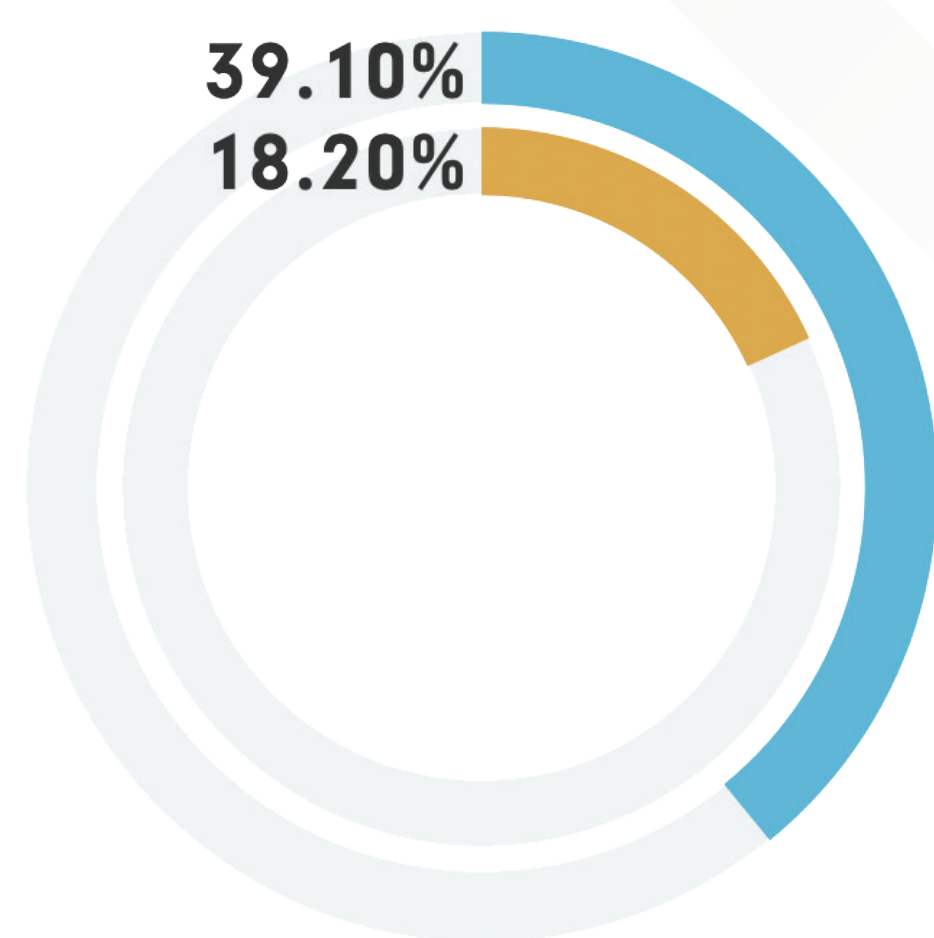

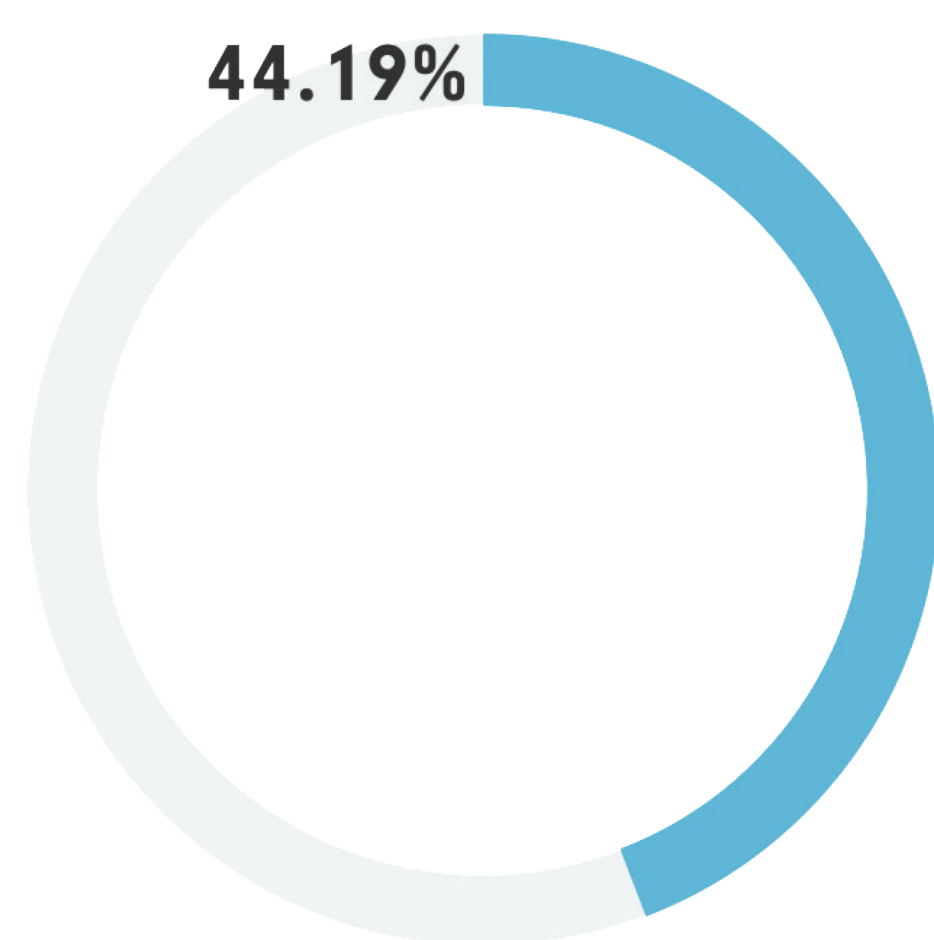
Women's Economic Empowerment

Women in the Arab States have income security, decent work, and economic autonomy.

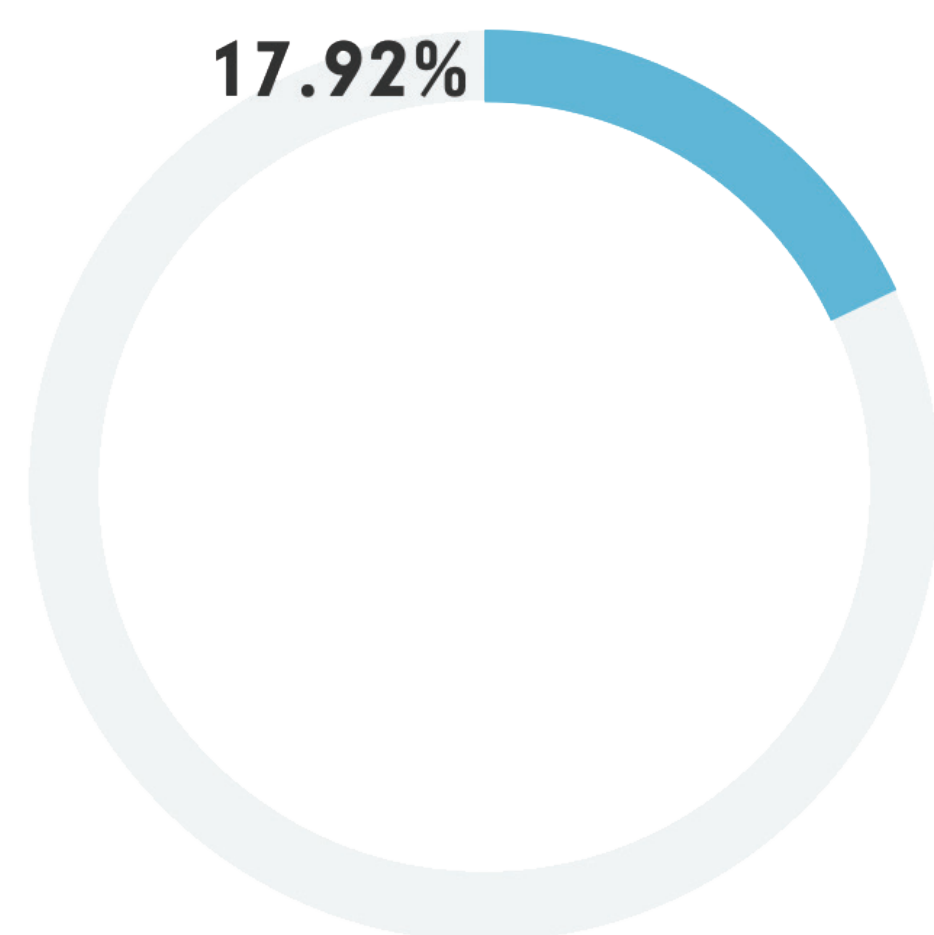


Unemployment with advanced education, (% of labour force with advanced education)

Labour force participation rate, female (% of total population) (modeled ILO estimate)

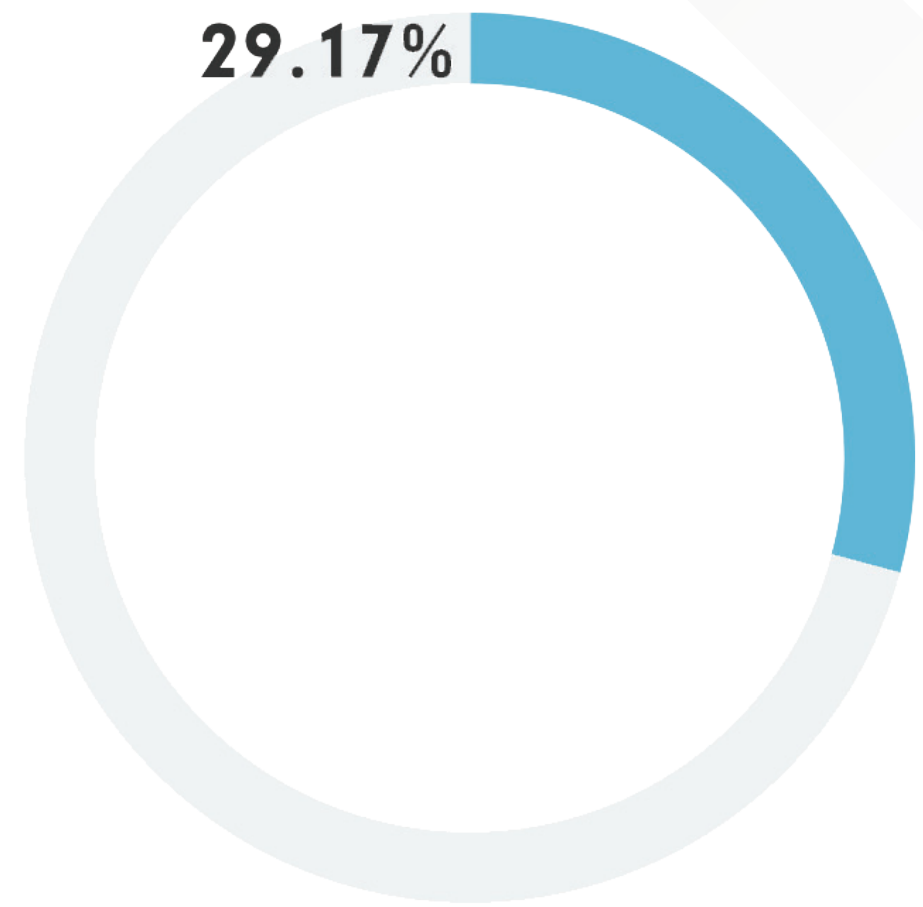

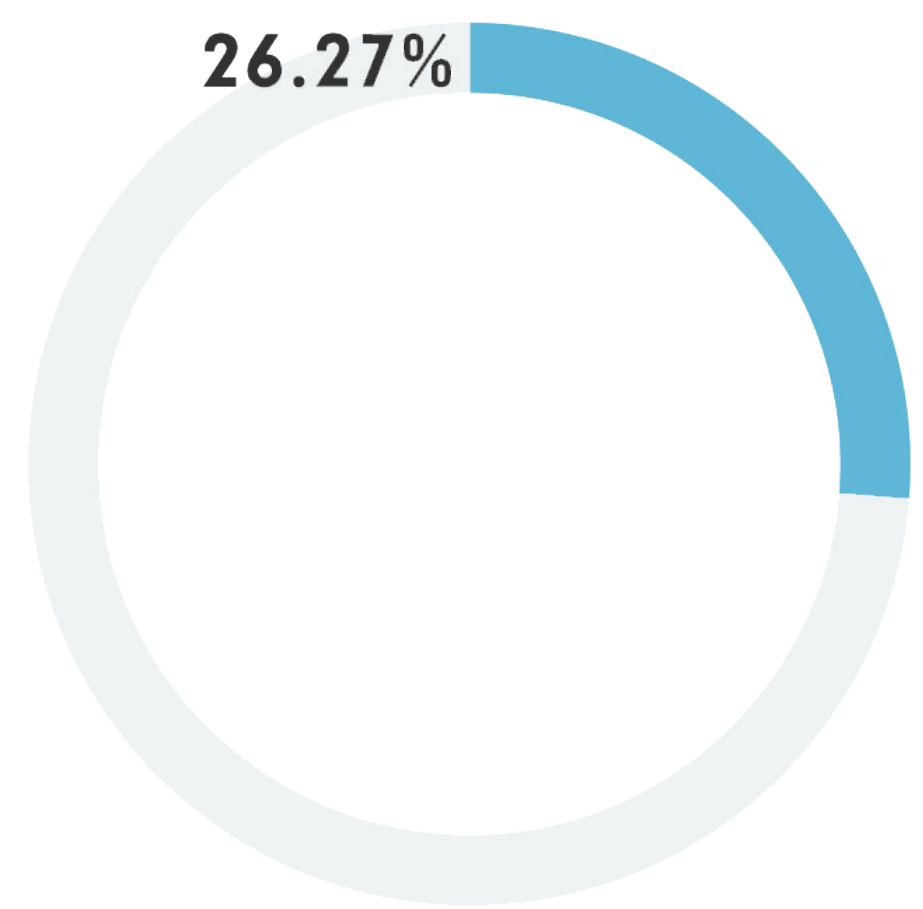
Gender and Governance

Women in the Arab States fully and equally participate in leadership and decision-making, and women and girls benefit from gender responsive governance.

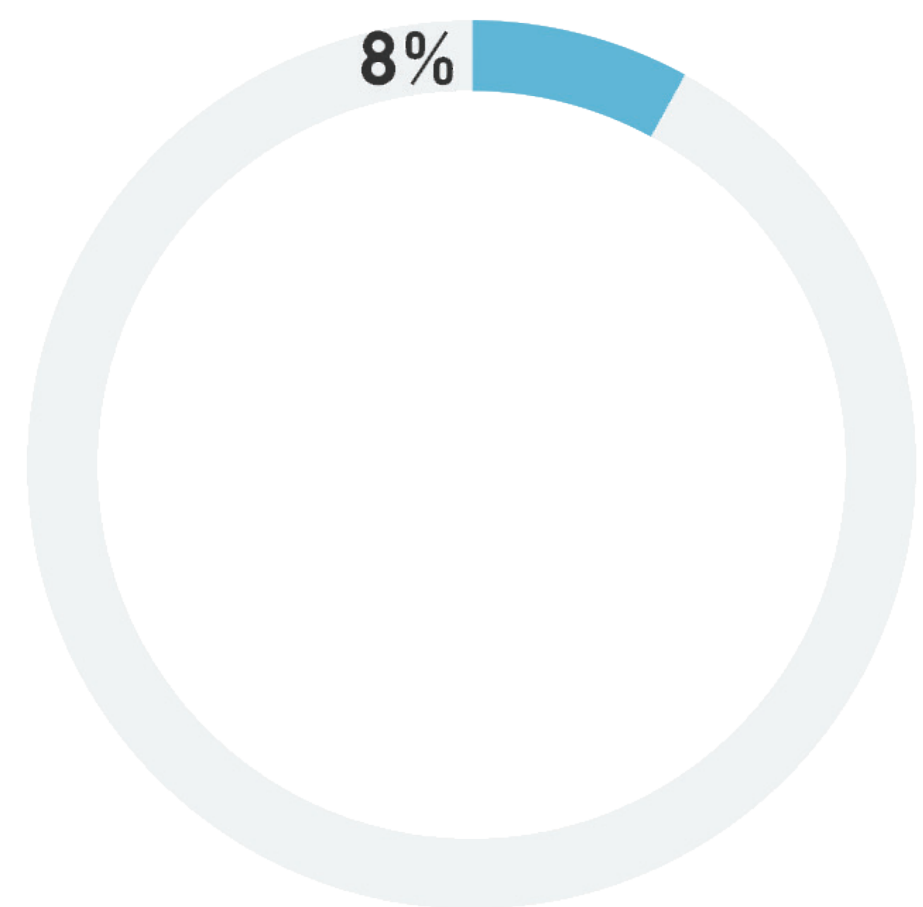


Proportion of women in ministerial level positions (%)

Share of women in board membership (percent)

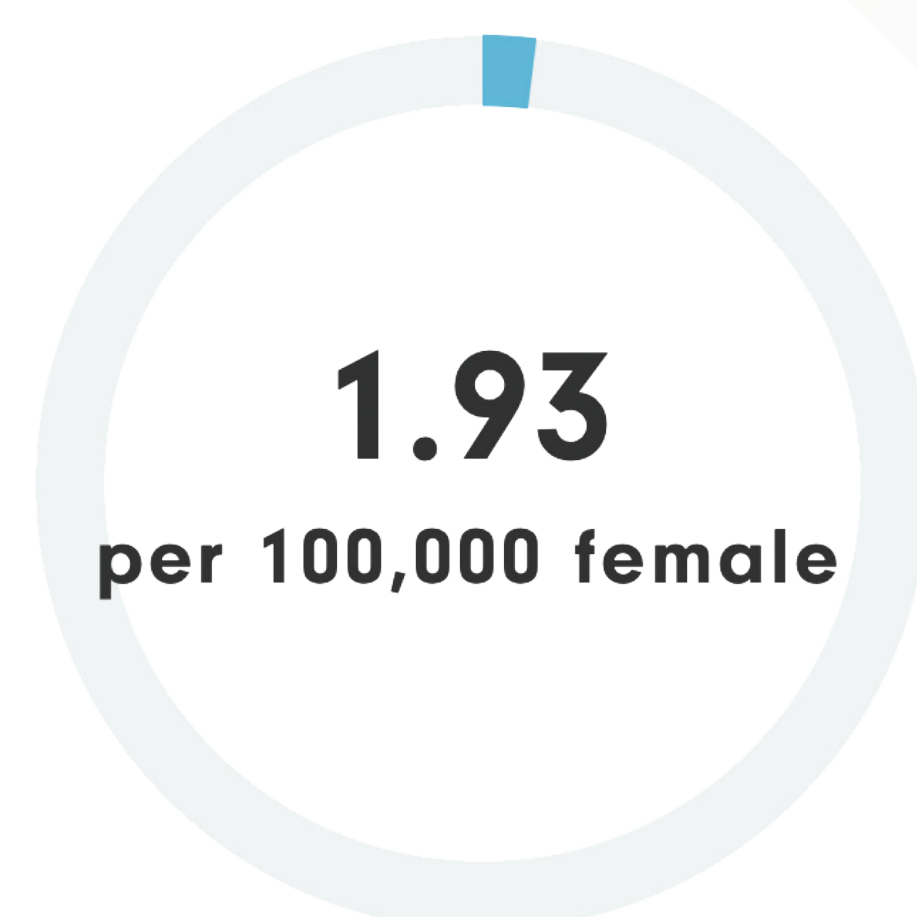

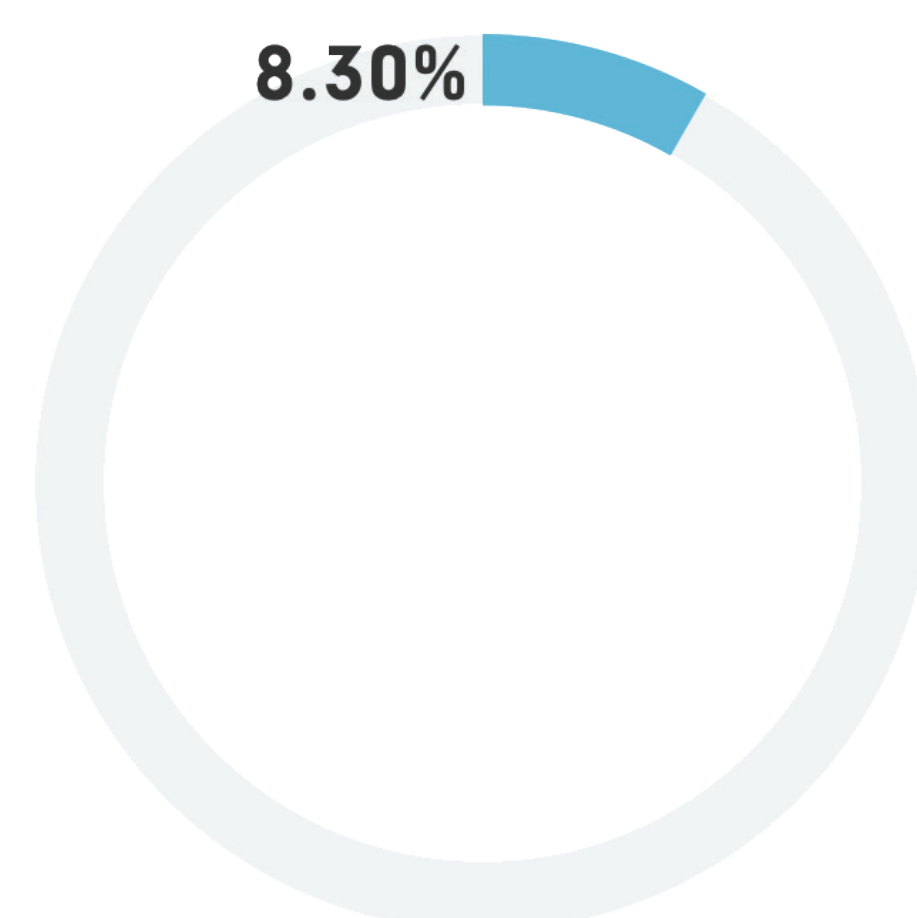
